ORDINANCE NO
AN ORDINANCE vacating the alley right-of-way adjacent and north of The Iowa Taproom at 215 E. 3 rd Street.
WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and
WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:
Sec. 1. That the alley right-of-way adjacent and north of The Iowa Taproom at 215 E. 3 rd Street more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated:
All of the East-West Alley lying North of Lot 3 in Block 2 of Scott and Dean's Addition, an Official Plat, now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa, Containing 2,112 square feet more or less.
Sec. 2. The City of Des Moines hereby reserves an easement upon the property described above for the continued use and maintenance of any utilities now in place, with the right of entry for servicing same.
Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County Iowa.
