ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF  
2016 CITY-WIDE PCC PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROGRAM  
AND FIXING A DATE FOR RECEIVING OF BIDS ON JULY 26, 2016  
AND PUBLIC HEARING ON AUGUST 8, 2016  
ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE IS \$450,000.00

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the attached communication recommending construction of the following improvement and the method of financing; and also including the recommendation of the Des Moines City Engineer, as the Engineer, submitting plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and Engineer's estimate of cost for the construction of the following improvement:

2016 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2016-014

The improvement includes drilling, doweling, furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines, Public Works Department, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa:

- S.E. 4th Street from E. McKinley Avenue to E. Philip Street
- 8th Place from Park Street to Center Street
- 9th Street from Keosauqua Way to School Street
- S.E. 18th Court from King Avenue to Dead End North
- S.E. 21st Street from E. Hughes Avenue to E. Park Avenue
- E. 22nd Street from Boyd Street to Hull Avenue
- 30th Street from Hickman Road to Sheridan Avenue
- E. 38th Court from Leyden Avenue to E. Douglas Avenue
- E. 40th Court from Morton Avenue to Boyd Avenue
- S.W. 40th Street from Park Avenue to S.W. 39th Street
- Crestmoor Place from 38th Place to Lower Beaver Road
- Evans Street from S.W. 15th Street to S.W. 16th Street
- Maish Avenue from 515 Maish Avenue to 807 Maish Avenue
- Miller Avenue from S.W. 5th Street to S.W. 7th Street

be and the same are hereby approved and accepted. The estimated construction cost for said improvement is \$450,000.00. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this Council hereby determines that it is necessary and advisable to construct said improvement in the manner set forth in the plans, specifications, and form of contract documents submitted by the Engineer; and that payment for the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the funding source identified below.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That proposals will be received by the City of Des Moines, at the office of the Des Moines City Clerk until 11:00 a.m. on July 26, 2016, for the construction of said improvement, and the taking of bids in the manner required by law. Proposals received will be opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the Shijiazhuang Room, 2nd Floor, City Administration Building, 400 E. Court Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa, at 11:00 a.m. on July 26, 2016, after which the bids together with a bid tabulation and recommendation of the Engineer will be presented to the City Council at its next meeting for action thereon.


