HONORABLE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL

Re: Report to Council

Pursuant to the authority and direction of Council authorizing the City Attorney to settle claims, lawsuits and workers compensation actions for a total sum not to exceed \$5,000, I submit to Council the following summary report of settlements made:

NICHOLAS JONES \$2,911.61 for auto damage to Claimant's vehicle occurring on October 8, 2015 due to slurry on the road at 4009 Oxford Street for which the City removed barricades before it was dry.

CENTURYLINK \$1,597.47 for damage to a buried cable line which was struck by a City backhoe at 130 E. Seneca Avenue on April 22, 2015.

PHYLLIS WEATHERLY \$429.50 for sewer backup damage to Claimant's property at 2926 E. Madison due to a blockage of grease in the City main on February 20, 2016.

MONE AYE \$1,642.00 for property damage to Claimant's illegally parked and unoccupied vehicle during snow plow operations on February 3, 2016.

ENTERPRISE RENT-A-CAR \$291.79 for car rental expenses incurred by Claimant Information Tools, Inc., due to an auto accident caused by a City police vehicle on December 29, 2015.

SCOTTY'S BODY SHOP \$3,164.32 for auto damage incurred by Claimant Information Tools, Inc., due to an auto accident caused by a City police vehicle on December 29, 2015.

ENTERPRISE RENT-A-CAR \$173.60 for car rental expenses incurred by Claimant Angela Knoblauch due to an auto accident caused by a City police vehicle on January 23, 2016.

NATHAN PETERSON \$525.00 for a sewer backup at 6008 Cottage Grove due to a blockage in the City's sewer main on April 17, 2016.

JAVIER SOLIS \$400.85 for damage to Claimant's power line/mast at 2700 E. 16th Street caused by a City yard waste vehicle when it lifted its bin and connected with the Claimant's power line on April 26, 2016.

AMANDA MITCHELL \$487.02 for plumbing costs associated with a sewer backup at 209 E. Philip on May 1, 2016, due to a root blockage in the City main.

KENT LUTZ and MELANIE ROCHA-LUTZ \$500.00 for damage to Claimant's fence at 4315 Chamberlain, which was caused by a solid waste truck on April 8, 2016.

RON WEAVER \$4,260.00 for auto damage caused by a City of Des Moines police vehicle while it was in active pursuit of a suspect vehicle on April 28, 2016, and struck Claimant's parked vehicle at 1600 E. 14th Street.

CUSTOM COACHWORKS \$2,029.79 for repair of damage to Claimant Jeff Renner's vehicle due to an auto accident caused by a City police car striking Claimant's parked car on March 14, 2016.

CAITLYN REINDERS \$3,043.75 for total loss to Claimant's vehicle due to an accident on May 13, 2016, when a City garbage truck struck Claimant's unoccupied, parked vehicle.

DAVID HEIDEMANN \$858.07 for Claimant's lost Iphone, which was found by a City police officer, who subsequently disposed of the phone in the garbage at a Norwalk Casey's store.

NIXON LAURIDSEN & NIXON LAURIDSEN TRUST \$695.00 for the total loss Claimant's tree at 1401 Casady Drive, which was broken off at the base by a police car while it was in pursuit of a suspect vehicle.

TONY MORO COLLISION CENTER \$1,163.45 for repair of damage to Claimant Joel Miller's vehicle due to a City solid waste truck rear-ending Claimant's vehicle while it was stopped at a red light on May 2, 2016.

CONSTANCE PRICE \$270.00 for damage to Claimant's fence at 120 30th Street caused by a clogged intake drain in a nearby drainage ditch.

HENRY SYMONS \$387.50 for damage to Claimant's vehicle when an unsecured water cooler fell of a fire truck and struck Claimant's vehicle on June 5, 2016.

SHAWNA SEVERINI \$898.61 for auto damage caused by a police vehicle on April 28, 2016, when it lost control and struck Claimant's parked vehicle.
