## HONORABLE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL

Re: Report to Council

Pursuant to the authority and direction of Council authorizing the City Attorney to settle claims, lawsuits and workers compensation actions for a total sum not to exceed \$5,000, I submit to Council the following summary report of settlements made:

TRAVELERS \$5,000.00 for deductible payment on claim of Ismet Kamencic for auto damage caused by a City snow plow when it struck Claimant's vehicle while stopped at a stop light on December 28, 2015.

TONY MORO COLLISION CENTER \$2,033.53 for auto damage to Claimant David Smith's vehicle, which was struck by a police squad car when it crossed the center line while pulling out of the Police Department parking lot on September 7, 2016.

DES MOINES WATER WORKS \$709.87 for damage to a water stop box located at 3900 15<sup>th</sup> Street by a City sewer crew on May 25, 2016.

CABLEVEY CONVEYORS \$744.50 for replacement cost of a Dell laptop computer which was removed from Claimant's vehicle during an arrest for OWI. The laptop fell of the hood of the squad car and was destroyed.

ALLSTATE INSURANCE \$1,041.23 for the property damage claim of Brandy Mooney due to a City garbage truck crossing the center lane on October 6, 2016 and striking Claimant's vehicle with its front end loader.

ANGELA COOK \$707.29 for damage to Claimant's legally parked and unoccupied vehicle when it was struck by a City garbage truck on August 31, 2016.

CENTURYLINK \$4,489.42 for damage to Claimant's buried cable line at 4315 Grand Avenue when a City backhoe hit the marked line on August 9, 2016.

CINDY and MARK HACKER \$30.00 for damage to Claimant's mailbox caused by a City recycle truck on December 14, 2016.

CENTURYLINK \$2,366.50 for damage to a properly marked underground wire at S.W. 42<sup>nd</sup> and River Oaks Drive due to the City's digging activities on May 31, 2016.

JOSHUA JONES \$654.26 for a personal injury claim which occurred at Teachout Aquatic Center on July 30, 2016, after Claimant slid down waterslide and a lifeguard's whistle lanyard became imbedded in his finger.

ABC ELECTRICAL \$3,080.46 for automobile damage caused when a City Public Works driver backed into Claimant's parked and unoccupied vehicle on November 4, 2016.

TRACY GOLDMAN \$2,253.83 for a sewer backup at 1101 11<sup>th</sup> Street on November 1, 2016 while the City was cleaning the sewer line.
