ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 78-26, and by repealing Section 102-459, relating to peddlers.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by

Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by

amending Section 78-26, and by repealing Section 102-459, relating to peddlers, as follows:

## Sec. 78-26. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

*Peddler* means any person carrying goods, merchandise or offering services who sells or offers for sale such goods, merchandise, or services from house to house or upon the public streets including any person who takes orders house to house for goods, merchandise or services for later delivery.

*Peddling* means the selling or offering for sale services, goods or merchandise which are carried by a person from house to house or upon the public streets including the taking of orders house to house for goods, merchandise, or services for later delivery.

## Sec. 102-459. -- Lunchwagons, fruit stands, shoe shining parlors Repealed by Ord. No. 15,---.

No person shall keep, maintain, stand or operate any shoe shining parlors on any street, sidewalk or alley within that section of the city, bounded on the east by the east line of East Ninth Street, on the west by the west line of West Twelfth Street, on the south by the south line of Cherry Street and the south line of Court Avenue and on the north by the north line of Des Moines Street and the north line of West Grand Avenue, except as otherwise provided in this article.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and

publication as provided by law.
