APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, IOWA STATE HISTORICAL PRESERVATION OFFICE, IOWA OFFICE OF THE STATE ARCHAEOLOGIST, AND THE CITY OF DES MOINES REGARDING THE DES MOINES SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT, DES MOINES, POLK COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, an assessment of the potential impact on natural and cultural resources is required for all wastewater and sewer projects financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Iowa State Historical Preservation Office, Iowa Office of the State Archaeologist and the City of Des Moines have prepared a Programmatic Agreement which includes a phased approach to investigation, evaluation, and mitigation of effects to properties eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places for the Lower Oak Park and Highland Park Sewer Separation project, Near West Side Sewer Separation project, and future sewer separation projects financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

1. That the Programmatic Agreement between Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Iowa State Historical Preservation Office, Iowa Office of the State Archaeologist and the City of Des Moines which includes a phased approach to investigation, evaluation, and mitigation of effects to properties eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places for the Lower Oak Park and Highland Park Sewer Separation project, Near West Side Sewer Separation project, and future sewer separation projects financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, copies to be placed on file in the office of the City Clerk upon final approval by the City Legal Department and City Engineering Department, be and are hereby approved subject to final approval by the City Legal Department.
