ONE YEAR AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF DES MOINES
AND THE CITY OF JOHNSTON FOR HOMELAND SECURITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, this agreement is made and entered into by and between the City of Des Moines and the City of Johnston for the purpose of providing the City of Johnston with the same protections and services offered to the communities that are a party to the Homeland Security Services 28E agreement that was filed September 14, 2016 with the Secretary of State's Office, State of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines will provide the same protections and services it provides under the Homeland Security Services 28E agreement to the City of Johnston the same as if the City of Johnston were an original party; and

WHEREAS, the City of Johnston will pay \$23,937 to the City of Des Moines in consideration for the protections and services provided under the agreement, and

WHEREAS, this agreement is entered into by the authority vested in each party's City Council to enter into contracts and it is acknowledged that this agreement is not required to be filed with the Secretary of State's Office.

WHEREAS, the effective date for services and protections to be provided by the City of Des Moines and the due date for the payment agreed to herein by the City of Johnston is July 1, 2017; and


WHEREAS, this agreement will terminate on June 30, 2018.

ONE YEAR AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF DES MOINES
AND THE CITY OF JOHNSTON FOR HOMELAND SECURITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, this agreement is made and entered into by and between the City of Des Moines and the City of Johnston for the purpose of providing the City of Johnston with the same protections and services offered to the communities that are a party to the Attached 28E agreement, hereinafter referred to as Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, Exhibit A is the CHAPTER 28E AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITIES OF DES MOINES, ALTOONA, BONDURANT, CARLISLE, GRIMES, MITCHELLVILLE, NORWALK, PLEASANT HILL, POLK CITY, AND WINDSOR HEIGHTS AND THE COUNTY OF POLK FOR THE FUNDING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF HOMELAND SECURITY SERVICES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN AREA that was filed September 14, 2016 with the Secretary of State's Office, State of Iowa.

NOW THEREFORE it is agreed that:

1. The City of Des Moines will provide the same protections and services it provides under Exhibit A to the City of Johnston the same as if the City of Johnston were an original party to Exhibit A
2. The City of Johnston will pay \$23,937 to the City of Des Moines in consideration for the protections and services provided under Exhibit A.
3. The City of Johnston will be bound by all the provisions applicable to the parties under Exhibit A as if it were an original party to Exhibit A.
4. This agreement is entered into by the authority vested in each party's City Council to enter into contracts and it is acknowledged that this agreement is not required to be filed with the Secretary of State's Office.
5. The effective date for services and protections to be provided by the City of Des Moines and the due date for the payment agreed to herein by the City of Johnston is July 1, 2017.
6. This agreement will terminate on June 30, 2018.






