NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines Iowa, that the Chief of Police or Chief's designee is hereby authorized to electronically sign and submit on behalf of the Mayor and Chief of Police the "FY2017 Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Report" to the U.S. Department of Justice acknowledging the City's compliance with federal forfeiture guidelines.
