APPROVAL OF CONTRACT AND BOND AND PERMISSION TO SUBLET ON 2018-2019 HMA PAVEMENT SCARIFICATION AND RESURFACING \$885,168.00

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the contract and bond, in the amount of \$885,168.00, executed by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 dated May 7, 2018, for the construction of the following improvement:

2018-2019 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 06-2018-005

The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

S.E. 5th Street from E. Philip Street to E. McKinley Avenue

E. 9th Street from E. University Avenue to Garfield Avenue

S.W. 14th Street from West Street to Burnham Avenue

The improvement includes scarification only of 3-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Work Department; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

S.E. 7th Street from E. Lacona Avenue to E. Bell Avenue E. Broad Street from S.E. 5th Street to S.E. 7th Street Hillside Avenue from S.W. 9th Street to Bancroft Street King Avenue from S.E. 14th Street to S.E. 8th Court Kirkwood Avenue from South Union Street to Indianola Avenue Palmer Place from Courtland Avenue east to dead end

The improvement includes furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct a Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) surfacing overlay of a single 2-inch lift on existing street surface, together with other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

16th Street from Locust Street to 15th Street 59th Street from Grand Avenue south to dead end 59th Street from Grand Avenue to Waterbury Road Cherry Street from 5th Street to 12th Street High Street from 8th Street to 10th Street Woodland Avenue from 10th Street to 12th Street.

The improvement includes construction of sidewalk ramps with Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk four (4) inches, six (6) inches or eight (8) inches thick, together with all necessary appurtenances; in accordance with the contract documents, at the following intersections located within the City of Des Moines:

1st Street & Ovid Avenue
S.E. 8th Court & King Avenue
16th Street & Walnut Street
39th Street & 40th Street
43rd Street & Forest Avenue
45th Place & Chamberlin Avenue
45th Place & Waveland Court
45th Place & Boulevard Place
47th Street & Amick Avenue
47th Street & Euclid Avenue



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the same to be performed in accordance with the plans and specifications which have been heretofore approved by this Council, be and the same are hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department. The attached "Contractor's Anticipated DBE/TSB Utilization" shows the Contractor's efforts to solicit DBE/TSB Participation in accordance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise/Targeted Small Business (DBE/TSB) Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Des Moines, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering and Department, and the City Clerk, be and is hereby authorized and directed to attest to same. No contract shall be deemed to exist between the City of Des Moines and said Bidder until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by this Council and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That after said contract has been executed by the Mayor, the City Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to return the Contractor's bid security in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the attached Permission to Sublet form, from said Contractor requesting permission to sublet designated items, be and is hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department; and each subcontractor is hereby granted permission to work on said improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Des Moines Finance Director is hereby authorized to encumber this contract amount against the funds as identified below, and to acquire Builder's Risk Insurance, if appropriate, for the above referenced improvement.
