APPROVING COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (IDNR) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE S.E. 14TH STREET BIO-RETENTION CELL PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$164,765

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2012, by Roll No. 12-0358, the City Council approved a 28E Cooperative Agreement with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and Polk County Conservation Board to develop a Water Quality Plan for Easter Lake to address impairments caused by excess nutrients and sediment delivery to Easter Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Easter Lake Water Quality Management Plan, dated October 2, 2012, has been developed and the IDNR desires to reimburse the City up to \$164,765 of the construction costs of a project for the S.E. 14th Street Bio-retention Cell project; and

WHEREAS, IDNR has prepared a Cooperative Agreement for such project, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department recommends approval of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the above described Cooperative Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the City Clerk's Office, is hereby approved, and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign such Agreement on behalf of the City and the City Clerk to attest to the Mayor's signature.
