ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 2-276, relating to exceptions to procurement of goods and services under competitive bidding or request for proposals process.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by

Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by

amending Section 2-276 relating to exceptions to procurement of goods and services under

competitive bidding or request for proposals process, as follows:

Sec. 2-726. Exceptions to Procurement of goods and services under competitive bidding or request for proposals process.

(u) Repair services for work on eligible private property funded by Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Polk County Housing Trust funds, where such procurements comply with applicable federal and state law and regulations.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and

publication as provided by law.
