APPROVAL OF CONTRACT AND BOND AND PERMISSION TO SUBLET ON 2019 RESIDENTIAL PAVING \$ 1,463,241.00

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That the contract and bond, in the amount of \$1,463,241.00, executed by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 dated July 15, 2019, for the construction of the following improvement:

2019 Residential Paving, 06-2019-016

Removal of existing Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement and surfacing materials by milling/scarifying to an average depth of four-inches, preparing subgrade/subbase, and reconstructing four-inches HMA pavement with two equal lifts, and replacing existing sidewalk ramps with ADA-compliant ramps as directed by the engineer at the following sites:

53rd Street from Franklin Avenue to Hickman Road 59th Street from Franklin Avenue to Francis Avenue Lincoln Avenue from 59th Street to 61st Street Francis Avenue from 61st Street to 62nd Street 49th Place from Urbandale Avenue south to dead-end Nierob Court from Washington Avenue north to dead-end 36th Street from Washington Avenue to Franklin Avenue E. Tiffin Avenue from E 15th Street to Villa Vista Drive Henderson Avenue from E 15th Street to Villa Vista Drive Richmond Avenue from E 15th Street to Villa Vista Drive Villa Vista Drive from Richmond Avenue to Henderson Avenue Nevada Avenue from E. 13th Street to York Street E. 31st Court from E. 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the same to be performed in accordance with the plans and specifications which have been heretofore approved by this Council, be and the same are hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department. The attached "Contractor's Anticipated DBE/TSB Utilization" shows the Contractor's efforts to solicit DBE/TSB Participation in accordance with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise/Targeted Small Business (DBE/TSB) Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Des Moines, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department, and the City Clerk, be and is hereby authorized and directed to attest to same. No contract shall be deemed to exist between the City of Des Moines and said Bidder until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by this Council and executed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That after said contract has been executed by the Mayor, the City Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to return the Contractor's bid security in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the attached Permission to Sublet form, from said Contractor requesting permission to sublet designated items, be and is hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department; and each subcontractor is hereby granted permission to work on said improvement.



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Des Moines Finance Director is hereby authorized to encumber this contract amount against the funds as identified below, and to acquire Builder's Risk Insurance, if appropriate, for the above referenced improvement.
