AUTHORIZING CITY OF DES MOINES MUNICIPAL HOUSING AGENCY TO SUBMIT THE MAINSTREAM VOUCHER PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency administers a Housing Choice Voucher Program funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, staff has prepared a Mainstream Voucher Program grant application to HUD for approximately \$536,808 of annual housing assistance payments; and

WHEREAS, Anawim Housing, Iowa Homeless Youth Center, and Primary Health Care have provided letters of intent to provide supportive services to Mainstream Voucher recipients; and

WHEREAS, utilization of Mainstream Vouchers will result in a cost-effective strategy to provide more housing options for non-elderly, disabled households.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Housing Governing Board, that submission of the Mainstream Voucher Program application on behalf of the City of Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon award of this grant by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the City Manager or his designee, the Community Development Director, is hereby authorized to execute and to implement the Grant. (Board Communication No. 19-360)
