## RESOLUTION SETTING DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE URBAN RENEWAL PLAN FOR THE INGERSOLL-GRAND COMMERCIAL URBAN RENEWAL AREA

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2012, by Roll Call No. 12-1113, the City Council approved the Ingersoll-Grand Commercial Urban Renewal Plan (the "Urban Renewal Plan") which seeks to enhance private development within the Ingersoll-Grand Commercial Urban Renewal Area though provision of infrastructure improvements and economic development assistance that will be provided in part with tax increment financing revenues to be generated in the urban renewal area; and,

WHEREAS, the Ingersoll-Grand Commercial Urban Renewal Area is generally located along and between Ingersoll and Grand Avenues, from Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to 43rd Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to consider a proposed Fifth Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan to amend the Urban Renewal Area boundary by reducing the size of the physical plan area by approximately 55 acres, updating all associated maps in Appendix B to reflect the updated boundary, and updating the financial condition report; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed Fifth Amendment is on file and available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk; and,

WHEREAS, the Urban Design Review Board is schedule to review the proposed Fifth Amendment at its regular meeting on October 15, 2019, and should be prepared to submit its report and recommendation to the City Council before the date proposed for public hearing by the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. A public hearing shall be held before the City Council to consider the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Ingersoll-Grand Commercial Urban Renewal Plan at 5:00 p.m. on November 4, 2019, in the City Council Chambers at City Hall.
- 2. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish notice of said public hearing in the accompanying form in the Des Moines Register on October 17, 2019.
- 3. The proposed Fifth Amendment is hereby submitted to the Urban Design Review Board for its review and recommendation, with said written recommendation requested to be received by the City Council prior to the date of public hearing.

4. The Economic Development Director or the Director's designee is hereby designated as the City's representative to the consultation proceedings with the Des Moines Independent School District, Polk County, Des Moines Area Community College, and Des Moines Area Regional Transit Authority. The consultation meeting shall be held prior to the date of public hearing at a time and location to be determined by the Director in accordance with Iowa Code §403.5(2). The Director shall cause notice of the consultation meeting, a copy of the Notice of Public Hearing, and a copy of the proposed Fifth Amendment to be mailed to each such affected taxing entity.
