WHEREAS, the Fire Department requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order in the amount of \$129,815, using 2020 CIP funding, for the repair of Medic 9 ambulance that was involved in a traffic accident on October 15, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the ambulance was originally procured from Foster Coach Sales using the competitively bid HGACBuy cooperative purchasing program, and for the purpose of remounting and performing structural repairs, Horton Emergency Vehicles, 3800 McDowell Road, Grove City, OH 43123 (Owner Tim Sullivan, President and CEO), is the only authorized repair center and as such is considered the sole source provider of the proprietary parts and repair services; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (c) provides for the procurement of repair services for equipment and machinery, or for the procurement of repair parts, when required repair parts are available only from a single factory source and are sold through a single area-wide distributor, and competitive bids for such repairs are thus not prospectively obtainable; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from FR013 Equipment Acquisition Funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the use of funds of \$129,815 for repair of the Medic 9 ambulance by Horton Emergency Vehicles.
