ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Sections 114-1103 and 114-1105, relating to speed limits and parking and parking fines in municipally owned parks.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by

Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by

amending Sections 114-1103 and 114-1105, relating to speed limits and parking and parking fines

in municipally owned parks, as follows:

Sec. 114-1103. Speed limits.

No person shall ride or drive in any public city park except upon the established roads and ways, and no person shall exceed a speed limit of-15_20 miles per hour at any time unless otherwise posted; provided, however, the speed limit on Birdland Drive extending from Sixth Avenue to Saylor Road shall be 30 miles per hour at all times.

Sec. 114-1105. Parking restrictions.

- No person shall park a vehicle in any public city park, cemetery, community center or city (a) recreational facility in such a manner as to block access to any road, driveway or building.
- No person shall park a vehicle in any public city park, cemetery, community center or city (b) recreational facility except in the places designated by the parks and recreation director.
- No person shall park a vehicle in Grandview Park except: (c)—
 - (1) In the lot at the west end of the park from sunrise to sunset.
 (2) In the lot near the tennis courts.
- Parking spaces shall be provided in the interior of Grandview Park for the handicapped. (d)-
- A violation of this section shall place such vehicle in the status of an illegally parked (ec) vehicle, and the vehicle may be dealt with pursuant to section 114-485.11 of this chapter.
- A person who violates any provision of this section shall pay a fine of $\frac{15.00 \text{}}{50.00}$. (fd)

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and

publication as provided by law.
