## RESOLUTION APPROVING ISSUANCE OF A REPLACEMENT QUIT CLAIM DEED FOR VACATED ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY TO STEVE OSGOOD AND DODY OSGOOD

WHEREAS, Steve Osgood and Dody Osgood are now the current owners of 2206 East 21<sup>st</sup> Street, and they and their predecessors in interest have had possession of and paid taxes on the portion of the alley adjoining said property since the City of Des Moines issued the quit claim deed in 1976; and

WHEREAS, Steve Osgood and Dody Osgood, as successors in interest to Ralph G. Reasoner, Sr. and Mildred C. Reasoner, have asked the City of Des Moines to issue a Replacement Quit Claim Deed conveying the east half of the vacated alley to them in order to clear title to their property.

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
