Dear Mayor Cownie and Council Members,

Consistent with the operating agreement with the City of Des Moines, the Board of Directors of the Greater Des Moines Public Art Foundation (GDMPAF) reviewed on 19 December 2019 a proposed public art project to be located along the 6th Avenue – which is part of a 1.2 mile streetscape project extending from the Des Moines River Bridge south to Interstate 235. The proposed public art project was created by contemporary artist Sheena Rose specifically for the 6th Avenue Corridor (6AC) district, in close collaboration with DART and GDMPAF.

Through a public art process, the artist was selected to create a series of unique designs to be digitally embedded into the glass panels of each DART bus shelter along 6AC. This series of designs will create a collection with a common theme, subject or inspiration to stitch together a visual identity for transit in this neighborhood. Each of the seven (7) designs will be repeated once and a total of fourteen (14) bus shelters will be installed in three phases. (See **Attachment A**)

Celebrated artist Sheena Rose is a Fulbright Scholar and holds a BFA Honors degree, as well as a MFA from The University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Her multi-disciplinary practice includes drawings, paintings, performance art, and new media. The artist has been recognized by numerous international awards and artist's residencies. Her works of art have been exhibited in prestigious exhibitions throughout the United States, as well as internationally in South America, Canada, Caribbean, Europe, Africa and Asia.

The GDMPAF, acting in its advisory capacity to the Des Moines City Council, has reviewed the established guidelines and criteria for the public art program in considering this proposal. After careful consideration, the GDMPAF has determined that the proposal is consistent with the standards of the public art program and enthusiastically recommends that the City approve the installation.

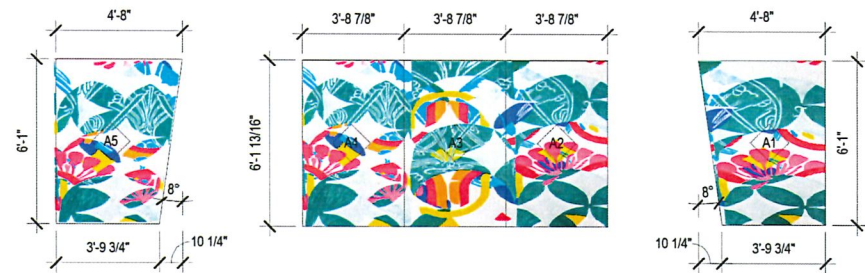

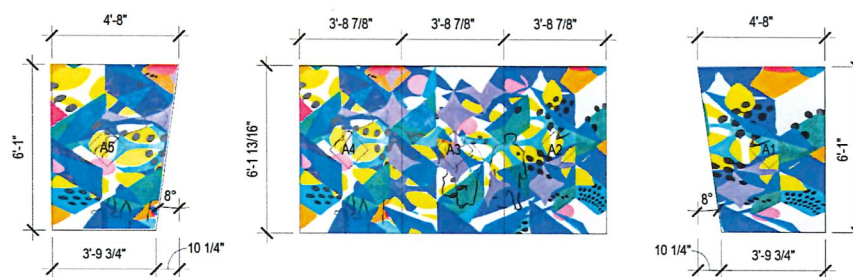

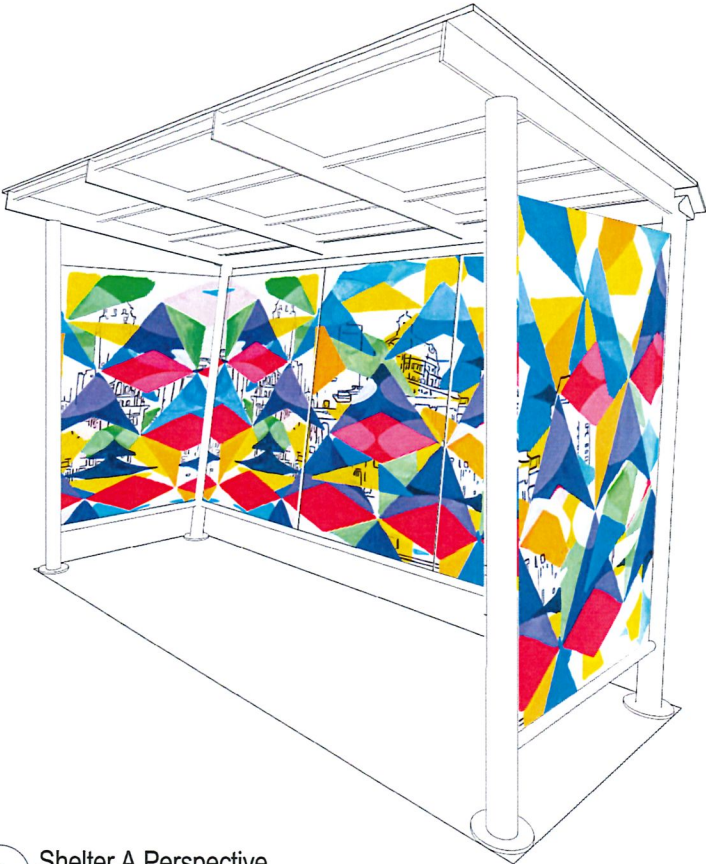

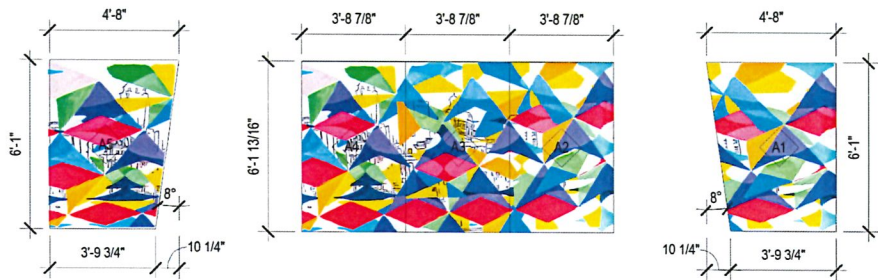

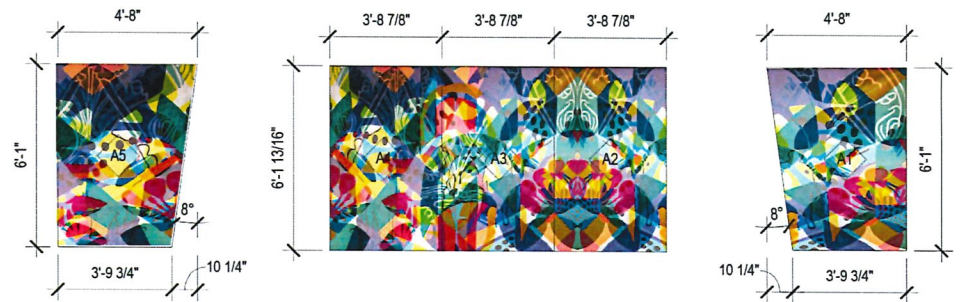

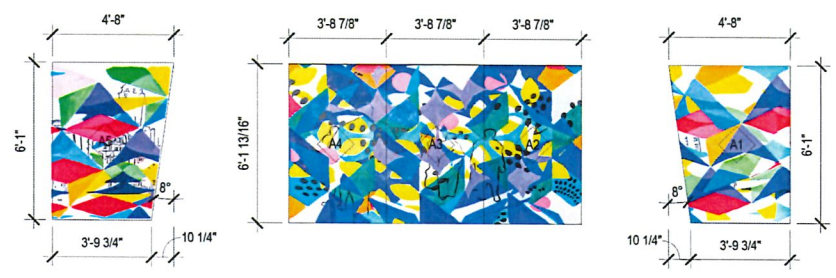
