E. 29th Street Rehabilitation from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue, 06-2019-006

The improvement includes pavement scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) patching, PCC sidewalk, pavement markings, traffic signal modifications, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 613-225/247, on E. 29th Street from Easton Boulevard to Euclid Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager or his or her designee. be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Des Moines, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department. No contract shall be deemed to exist between the City of Des Moines and said Bidder until said contract has been executed by the Bidder, and shall have been approved by the City Manager or his or her designee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the attached Permission to Sublet form, from said Contractor requesting permission to sublet designated items, be and is hereby approved, subject to receipt of the contract and bond approved as to form by the Legal Department, and certificate of insurance acceptable to the Engineering Department; and each subcontractor is hereby granted permission to work on said improvement.
