WHEREAS, the Fire Department has requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order for the purchase of two (2) Physio-Control LifePak 15 Cardiac monitor-defibrillators, and three (3) Lucas 3, v3.1 Chest Compression Systems; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the ambulance equipment will assist the Fire Department in standardizing its ambulance fleet. The purchase of two (2) Lifepak 15 monitor-defibrillators, and three (3) Lucas Compression Systems, will allow the Fire Department to equip reserve ambulances, that will be deployable in situations where additional ambulances are needed to provide coverage for the city during large scale events; and


WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-710 (a) provides that the City Council may on a case by case basis for good cause shown, exempt contracts for the provision of goods and/or services from the competitive procurement requirements of this subdivision, and authorize use of an informal competitive bidding procedure or authorize direct procurement without a competitive process for the procurement of goods and/or services to cost in excess of \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$110,507.70, which has received approval from the Budget Review Committee, is available from 2020-2025 CIP, Page Fire Protection Improvements - 4, FRO13-Equipment Acquisition-Fire Department, Being: G.O. Bonds Issued; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the procurement of the above described equipment be exempted from the competitive bidding requirements for good cause shown, pursuant to Section 2-710(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that good cause has been shown to exempt the procurement of the above described equipment from the Procurement Ordinance competitive bidding requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council accepts and approves the purchase of the ambulance equipment, from Stryker Medical, 3800 E Centre Ave, Portage, MI 49002, Brad Saar, President, for a total amount of \$110,507.70.
