HOLD HEARING FOR CONSIDERATION OF A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH DOWNTOWN DES MOINES SELF-SUPPORTED MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, D/B/A OPERATION DOWNTOWN, FOR INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND DISPLAY OF ARTWORK WITHIN THE 8TH STREET VIADUCT NORTH OF CHERRY STREET AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT AND ASSOCIATED INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines owns and maintains the 8th Street Viaduct ("City Property") in downtown Des Moines as street right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Downtown Des Moines Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District, an Iowa nonprofit corporation d/b/a Operation Downtown ("hereinafter Licensee") desires to enter into a License Agreement with the City of Des Moines to use a portion of the underside of the 8th Street Viaduct north of Cherry Street to install, maintain and display artwork consisting of RGB Color LED Flood Lights created by artist Alex Braden and titled "BOREALIS" and the associated electrical conduit and electrical box; and

WHEREAS, Operation Downtown is the owner of artwork consisting of RGB Color LED Flood Lights with each light's color cycling through varying hues and brightness within the existing Viaduct architecture, including the associated electrical conduit and electrical box to be installed on one pier of the Viaduct, created by artist Alex Braden and titled "BOREALIS"; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Des Moines Art Foundation ("**PAF**") has the responsibility to conduct the affairs and activities of the Public Art Program under an amended Contract approved by the City Council by Roll Call No. 04-145 on July 12, 2004, which includes the duty to prepare recommendations for the City Council's consideration for proposed public arts related projects; and

WHEREAS, the PAF has advised the City Council by letter dated November 20, 2018, and further by letter dated April 23, 2020, that the proposed installation of the artwork on the licensed premises is consistent with the standards of the public art program and recommends that the City approve the installation; and

WHEREAS, Operation Downtown will retain ownership of the artwork, and provide for maintenance of the artwork, including maintenance and repair of the electrical components of the artwork, and take on sole responsibility for any and all utility costs such as but not limited to electricity for the artwork; and

WHEREAS, the Access Advisory Board approved the placement of the Artwork at its May 20, 2020 meeting; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the License and a Non -Exclusive, Limited Copyright License in connection with the display of the artwork; and Agreement, the artist is required to execute a Waiver of Visual Artist



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Rights Act and a Non-Exclusive, Limited Copyright License in connection with display of the artwork; and

WHEREAS, there is no known current or future public need for the property proposed to be licensed, and the City will not be inconvenienced by the license of said Property; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said proposal to enter into a License Agreement with Downtown Des Moines Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District, an Iowa nonprofit corporation d/b/a Operation Downtown as given to all necessary parties as provided by law, setting forth the time and place for hearing on said proposal, including how to participate electronically and telephonically; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Council direction, those interested in the proposed agreement, both for and against, have been given an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. Upon due consideration of the facts and statements of interested persons, any and all objections to the proposed License Agreement by and between City of Des Moines and Downtown Des Moines Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District, an Iowa nonprofit corporation d/b/a Operation Downtown, of a portion of the underside of the 8th Street Viaduct between Cherry Street and Mulberry Street, Des Moines, Iowa, described as follows, are hereby overruled and the hearing is closed.
- 2. There is no public need or benefit for the right-of-way proposed to be licensed, and the public would not be inconvenienced by reason of the City of Des Moines entering into a license agreement with Downtown Des Moines Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District, d/b/a Operation Downtown, for use of a portion of the underside of the 8th Street Viaduct north of Cherry Street to install, maintain and
