SET PUBLIC HEARING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 ACTION PLAN FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) 2015-2019 CONSOLIDATED PLAN

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) was signed into Public Law 116-136, which provides additional Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV) funding to prepare, prevent, and respond to coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2020, HUD allocated the City of Des Moines \$2,231,212 in CDBG-CV and \$1,108,334 in ESG-CV funds for activities to respond to the public health crisis; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2020, HUD awarded a second ESG-CV allocation to the City of Des Moines in the amount of \$2,081,414 for activities to respond to the public health crisis; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 24 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 91.505, an entitlement jurisdiction receiving federal funding, such as the City of Des Moines, must amend its most recently approved Action Plan and Consolidated Plan to carry out an activity not previously described in the plans; and

WHEREAS, HUD has issued several regulatory waivers and suspensions for federally funded programs, including Consolidated Plan and citizen participation requirements in 24 CFR 91, in conjunction with the CARES Act; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020, HUD acknowledged the City of Des Moines' intent to waive 1.) the citizen participation 30-day public comment period for Consolidated Plan amendments to no less than five days and 2.) citizen participation reasonable notice and opportunity to comment in the city's citizen participation plan; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, by public hearing following notice, to obtain the views of citizens regarding community development and housing needs and to provide a forum for citizen comment on the City's proposed 2019 Action Plan amendment; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide an opportunity for citizens to comment on the proposed 2019 Action Plan amendment, copies of the plan's changes to respond to coronavirus will be available for review on the City of Des Moines web site, dsm.city, under the Consolidated Planning web page, until November 23, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

1. A public hearing to obtain the views of citizens regarding community development and housing needs in Des Moines and the City's proposed 2019 Action Plan amendment shall be held on November 23, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. in the Second Floor Board Room in the Richard A. Clark Municipal Services Center at 1551 East Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa and also held via teleconference.

2. The notice of hearing on file with the City Clerk as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this notice in the Des Moines Register on November 14, 2020.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED 2019 ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT CONSOLIDATED PLAN

TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS AND PERSONS:

In accordance with 24 CFR Part 91, subpart B of the federal regulations relative to citizen participation for Community Planning and Development Programs and applicable waivers made available to those requirements through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), the City of Des Moines has developed amendments to the 2019 Action Plan and the Citizen Participation Plan for the 2015-2019 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Consolidated Plan.

The proposed 2019 Action Plan and Citizen Participation Plan amendments are available for review on the city's website, dsm.city, under the Consolidated Planning web page, and will remain available until the amendments are approved by the City Council, which is anticipated to be November 23, 2020.

The proposed 2019 Action Plan and Citizen Participation Plan amendments include the activities that will be allocated Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV) funding to prepare, prevent, and respond to coronavirus. On June 9, 2020, HUD allocated the City of Des Moines \$2,081,414 in a second allocation of ESG-CV funds for activities to respond to the public health crisis.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council will consider said amendment after a public hearing to be held at 5:00 p.m. on November 23, 2020, in the 2nd Floor, MSC Board Room, Richard A. Clark Municipal Services Center, 1551 E. M.L. King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa. Given Mayor Cownie's March 17, 2020 Proclamation, as amended prohibiting indoor gatherings of ten or more persons on public property, Section One of the Governor's June 25, 2020 Proclamation strongly encouraging vulnerable Iowans to limit participation in gatherings of any size and any purpose during the COVID19 outbreak and the City Manager's decision to delay the opening of City buildings to the public due to the positive trend upward of COVID-19 cases in Polk County and the need to maintain safety, it is impossible and impractical to have physical public access to the meeting location and the meeting will be conducted electronically with electronic public access to the meeting location as set forth below.
