RESOLUTION FIXING DATE FOR A MEETING ON THE AUTHORIZATION OF A LOAN AGREEMENT AND THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$47,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION URBAN RENEWAL CAPITAL LOAN NOTES OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, STATE OF IOWA (FOR ESSENTIAL CORPORATE URBAN RENEWAL PURPOSES), AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE THEREOF

WHEREAS, by Roll-Call No. 00-788, adopted March 20, 2000, this Council found and determined that certain areas located within the City are eligible and should be designated as an urban renewal area under Iowa law, and approved and adopted the Urban Renewal Plan for the Metro Center Urban Renewal Area (which was created by the consolidation of the Riverpoint Capitol-Center Development Area Urban Renewal Project and the Capitol-Center Development Area Urban Renewal Project by Roll-Call No. 00-788 as the Ninth Amendment to the Riverpoint Capitol-Center Development Area Urban Renewal Plan and Roll-Call No. 00-789 as the Thirty-Third Amendment to the Capitol-Center Development Area urban Renewal Plan), which Plan is on file in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, by Roll-Call No. 00-1927, 00-4270, 00-4536, 00-4679, 01-3224, 02-1596, 03-1800, 07-1015, 08-2228, 11-0628, 12-1970, 13-0239, 13-1028, 14-0437, 14-1320, 15-1173, 15-1996, 16-0514, 17-0151, 17-0620, 17-1786, 18-0628, 18-1802, 19-0752, 19-1772, 20-0655 and 20-²¹⁴⁷this Council approved and adopted Amendments No. 1-27 to the Plan for the Metro Center Urban Renewal Area; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and advisable that the City of Des Moines, State of Iowa, should provide for the authorization of a Loan Agreement and issuance of General Obligation Urban Renewal Capital Loan Notes, to the amount of not to exceed \$47,000,000, as authorized by Sections 384.24A, 384.25 and 403.12, of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of providing funds to pay costs of carrying out essential corporate urban renewal purpose project(s) as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the Loan Agreement and Notes shall be payable from the Debt Service Fund; and

WHEREAS, before a Loan Agreement may be authorized and General Obligation Urban Renewal Capital Loan Notes, issued to evidence the obligation of the City thereunder, it is necessary to comply with the provisions of the Code of Iowa, as amended, and to publish a notice of the proposal and of the time and place of the meeting at which the Council proposes to take action for the authorization of the Loan Agreement and Notes and to receive oral and/or written objections from any resident or property owner of the City to such action.



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WHEREAS, before notes may be issued, it is necessary to comply with the procedural requirements of Chapters 384 and 403 of the Code of Iowa, and to publish a notice of the proposal to issue such notes and the right to petition for an election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF DES MOINES, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That this Council meet in the 2nd Floor, MSC Board Room, Richard A. Clark Municipal Services Center, 1551 E. M.L. King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa, at 5:00 P.M., on the 11th day of January, 2021, for the purpose of taking action on the matter of the authorization of a Loan Agreement and issuance of not to exceed \$47,000,000 General Obligation Urban Renewal Capital Loan Notes, for essential corporate urban renewal purposes, the proceeds of which notes will be used to provide funds to pay the costs of aiding in the planning, undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects under the authority of Iowa Code chapter 403 and the Urban Renewal Plan for the Metro Center Urban Renewal Area, as amended, including funding urban renewal projects designed to protect the interests of the City and preserve the availability of parking for use by the public, which may include acquiring a privately constructed parking garage and adjacent parcels, and/or providing financial assistance, including but not limited to providing long term financing for such projects.

Section 2. To the extent any of the projects or activities described in this resolution may be reasonably construed to be included in more than one classification under Division III of Chapter 384 of the Code of Iowa, the Council hereby elects the "essential corporate purpose" classification and procedure with respect to each such project or activity, pursuant to Section 384.28 of the Code of Iowa.

Section 3. The Clerk is authorized and directed to proceed on behalf of the City with the negotiation of terms of a Loan Agreement and the issuance of General Obligation Urban Renewal Capital Loan Notes, evidencing the City's obligations to a principal amount of not to exceed \$47,000,000, to select a date for the final approval thereof, to cause to be prepared such notice and sale information as may appear appropriate, to publish and distribute the same on behalf of the City and this Council and otherwise to take all action necessary to permit the completion of a loan on a basis favorable to the City and acceptable to the Council.

Section 4. That the Clerk is hereby directed to cause at least one publication to be made of a notice of the meeting, in a legal newspaper, printed wholly in the English language, published at least once weekly, and having general circulation in the City. The publication to be not less than ten clear days nor more than twenty days before the date of the public meeting on the issuance of the Notes.

Section 5. The notice of the proposed action to issue notes shall be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, State of Iowa, will hold a public hearing on the 11th day of January 2021, at 5:00 P.M., in the 2nd Floor, MSC Board Room, Richard A. Clark Municipal Services Center, 1551 E. M.L. King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa. Due to public health concerns related to COVID-19, as authorized by emergency proclamation of the Governor of the State of Iowa and in accordance with the emergency proclamation of the Mayor and the City Manager’s decision to delay the opening of City buildings to the public it is impossible or impractical to have physical public access to the City Council meeting location and this meeting will be held electronically with electronic public access to the meeting. At this meeting the Council proposes to take additional action for the authorization of a Loan Agreement and the issuance of not to exceed \$47,000,000 General Obligation Urban Renewal Capital Loan Notes, for essential corporate urban renewal purposes, to provide funds to pay the costs of aiding in the planning, undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects under the authority of Iowa Code chapter 403 and the Urban Renewal Plan for the Metro Center Urban Renewal Area, as amended, including funding urban renewal projects designed to protect the interests of the City and preserve the availability of parking for use by the public, which may include acquiring a privately constructed parking garage and adjacent parcels, and/or providing financial assistance, including but not limited to providing long term financing for such projects. Principal and interest on the proposed Loan Agreement will be payable from the Debt Service Fund.

At any time before the date of the meeting, a petition, asking that the question of issuing such Notes be submitted to the legal voters of the City, may be filed with the Clerk of the City,



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including the drop box on the east side of the City Hall building, during non-business hours, in the manner provided by Section 362.4 of the Code of Iowa, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 384.24(3)(q), 384.24A, 384.25 and 403.12 of the Code of Iowa.

At the above meeting the Council shall receive oral or written objections from any resident or property owner of the City to the above action. After all objections have been received and considered, the Council will at the meeting or at any adjournment thereof, take additional action for the authorization of a Loan Agreement and the issuance of the Notes to evidence the obligation of the City thereunder or will abandon the proposal to issue said Notes. Any person or organization desiring to submit written objections regarding this matter may direct such written objections to the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Dr., Des Moines, Iowa 50309, including the drop box on the east side of the City Hall building, prior to 4:00 p.m. on January 11, 2021.
