AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS IN THE THIRD FUNDING CYCLE OF IOWA'S VOLKSWAGEN SETTLEMENT ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION TRUST FOR ZERO EMISSION VEHICLE SUPPLY EQUIPMENT IN APRIL 2022.

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) is the lead state agency administering settlement funds from an Environmental Mitigation Trust to reduce nitrogen oxides emissions established by Volkswagen in settlement of an Environmental Protection Agency action against Volkswagen; and

WHEREAS, The Volkswagen settlement and, in partnership with the National Biodiesel Foundation for Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA.) National Grants Program has funding potentially available to assist with purchasing and installation of community electric vehicle charging stations; and

WHEREAS, Engineering Department staff propose to prepare applications for such grant funds to procure and install electric vehicle charging stations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. The City Council of the City of Des Moines hereby expresses its support to investigate and apply for this grant.
2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to sign the application and any forms required by IDOT to proceed with the application process and make the certifications required by the application.
