WHEREAS, the City originally entered into a 28E Agreement with Polk County on November 5, 1990 by Roll Call No. 90-4932, to address housing and neighborhood revitalization issues within the City of Des Moines; and

WHEREAS, the NFC provides for home improvement and home purchase loans in targeted neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, NFC is seeking approval to update the NFC Lending Areas in the City of Des Moines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the attached map of eligible neighborhoods for the NFC's Neighborhood Revitalization Program is approved.

Re: Update of NFC Lending Area

Neighborhood Finance Corporation (NFC) is requesting that the City Council approve an update to the NFC Lending Area. When the NFC Lending Area was updated in 2021, a portion of the Merle Hay and Sheridan Gardens neighborhoods were not included. We would now like to include the northern part of the Merle Hay Neighborhood, and the small portion on the eastern-edge of the Sheridan Gardens Neighborhood so that the NFC Lending Area reflects the neighborhood boundaries.


I have attached the proposed new lending area map for the City of Des Moines (Attachment A). I have also attached our current map for Polk County (Attachment B) for comparison. In the Merle Hay Neighborhood the area north of Hickman (Hwy 6), and in the Sheridan Gardens Neighborhood the area east of E. 42nd over to E. 43rd Ct, are not included on the 2021 map.

NFC is requesting that the City Council approve the Neighborhood Finance Corporation Lending Area as proposed in Attachment A. NFC will start using the new lending area as soon as we have approval from the City Council and the Polk County Supervisors. This update has already been approved by the NFC Board of Directors. 

2021 NFC LENDING MAP


