APPROVING ARPA FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH NEIGHBORHOOD FINANCE CORPORATION FOR THE ENERGY ADVANTAGE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA") to provide relief to combat the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City has received ARPA funding from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds and the City desires to aid nonprofit organizations to address the disparate inequities that impacted the Des Moines community; and

WHEREAS, Neighborhood Finance Corporation ("NFC") has created the Energy Advantage Program ("Project"), which will provide \$10,000 deferred loans at 0% interest to meet qualifying home renovation and energy improvements to residents within the City, and, for those earning below 60% AMI, may also be paired with other weatherization programs for a no-cost alternative; and

WHEREAS, the Project will serve the public purposes of improving the quality of affordable housing units within the City, increase the supply of affordable housing units within the City, and preserve the supply of current affordable housing units within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter in to a ARPA Funding Agreement ("Agreement") to provide a financial grant in the amount of \$1,500,000 in support of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, by Roll Call No. 22-1150, the City Council authorized the City Manager to apply American Rescue Plant Act (ARPA) funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 to the expenses for the Project, assuring that the City funds shall be used for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, due to the Agreement, said ARPA funds will be reallocated for the provision of government services within the general fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

- 1. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to reallocate the funds from Roll Call No. 22-1150 for the provision of government services within the general fund.
- 2. The Grant Agreement between the City and NFC for the Project for a grant not to exceed \$1,500,000 is hereby approved and, subject to the Legal Department's approval of the
