## HEARING AND ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS CERTIFIED FOR LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 384.15A requires a public hearing for City Council adoption of a resolution establishing the total maximum property tax dollars that may be certified for levy including the property tax levies specified in Iowa Code Subsection 384.15A(2) ("affected property tax levies"); and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2023 by Roll Call No. 23-0159, the City Council set the public hearing on adoption of the resolution establishing the total maximum property tax dollars that may be certified for levy for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 for hearing on February 20, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa and public notice of such hearing in the prescribed form has been published as provided by law in the Des Moines Register on February 8, 2023; and

WHEREAS, public notice of such hearing has been posted and clearly identified on the City internet website for public viewing beginning on February 8, 2023 and public notice of such hearing or an electronic link to such notice has been posted on each social media account maintained by the City on February 8, 2023; and

WHEREAS, those residents and property owners of the City interested in the City's proposed total maximum property tax dollars that may be certified for levy for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, have been given an opportunity to present to the City Council written and oral objections to the proposed maximum property tax dollar amount for consideration at this public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

- 1. All oral and written objections presented by residents and property owners of the City have been received and given due consideration and the public hearing on the City of Des Moines proposed total maximum property tax dollars that may be certified for levy for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 is hereby closed.
- 2. The maximum property tax dollars for the affected property tax levies for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 shall not exceed the following total:

Significant increases include increases in our druger.

Significant increases include increases in countracts and services provided by third parties, employee expenses, and health care costs. This includes additional staff for IT security and funding for replacement in-car cameras for police accountability. The City of Des Moines is reducing its Debt Service Levy (not provided in this worksheet) by \$0.05 from \$2.91 to \$2.86 and shifting \$0.05 to the Operational Levy listed on this Notice of Public Hearing establishing the maximum property tax rate. There is no net change to the overall tax rate being proposed.
