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# ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER OF PRINCIPAL FORGIVENESS AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 ON SEWER REVENUE CAPITAL LOAN NOTES, SERIES 2022C

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2022 by Roll Call No. 22- 1092 the City Council authorized and approved a form of loan and disbursement agreement between the City of Des Moines, Iowa and the Iowa Finance Authority (IFA), Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) authorizing and providing for the issuance and securing of the payment of \$7,035,000 of Sewer Revenue Capital Loan Notes, Series 2022C; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager received the attached letter dated March 16, 2023 from the DNR offering \$1,000,000 in principal forgiveness of Series 2022C loan; and

WHEREAS, the principal forgiveness will require signage be placed on the construction sites for Building A Better America emblem and EPA logo and compliance with all SRF Program requirements, as applicable; and

WHEREAS, the original loan agreement must be amended, and staff will work with Bond Counsel to prepare the necessary amendments for future Council action; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to return the executed attached letter accepting the principal forgiveness award.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

- 1. That the City Council hereby accepts the offer of principal forgiveness award and Terms and Conditions as outlined in the March 16, 2023 letter from the DNR on the Sewer Revenue Capital Loan Notes, Series 2022C, and authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute and return on behalf of the City of Des Moines the signed letter evidencing the City's acceptance of the principal forgiveness award.
- 2. Staff is authorized and directed to work with Bond Counsel and IFA to implement the necessary amendments to the Loan and Disbursement Agreement.

- 1. The City of Des Moines has executed a loan for \$7,035,000. The amount of principal forgiveness applied to this loan will be \$1,000,000 dollars.
- 2. Prior to applying principal forgiveness, the original loan agreement must be amended. The City will need to engage their Bond Counsel to prepare the proceedings for any required actions by the City Council.
- 3. Once the project is complete and all SRF final documents have been completed by the City, principal forgiveness will be applied to the outstanding loan balance. The remaining amount of the SRF loan will be subject to the usual terms of the SRF loan program.
- 4. The loan initiation fee assessed will be refunded to the City and applied as principal reduction to the outstanding loan balance at the same time as the principal forgiveness is applied.
- 5. This principal forgiveness award is subject to compliance with all SRF Program requirements, as applicable, including but not limited to American Iron and Steel Act, Environmental Review, Davis-Bacon Act, Civil Rights Laws, and State of Iowa public bidding laws.

#### **Specific Terms and Conditions**

- 1. <u>Signage Requirements</u>: The BIL signage term and condition requires a physical sign displaying the official Building a Better America emblem and EPA logo be placed at construction sites for BIL-funded projects.
  - a. <u>Building A Better America Emblem:</u> The City will ensure that a sign is placed at construction sites supported under this award displaying the official Building A Better America emblem and must identify the project as a "project funded by President Biden's Bipartisan Infrastructure Law."

Instead, the EPA logo must be accompanied with a statement indicating that the City received financial assistance from EPA for the project.
