RESOLUTION RELEASING SUBDIVISION BOND FOR BRIDGE DISTRICT PLAT 2

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018, by Roll Call Number 18-1832 the City Council approved the subdivision bond for the development entitled Bridge District Plat 2, located in the vicinity of the 800 block of E 2nd Street, to be developed by Bridge District II, LLC, Caleb Smith, Authorized Agent, and accepted bond number IAC588316 from Merchants Bonding Company, to secure the satisfactory completion and payment of the required sidewalk improvements and as-built survey costs; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has certified that the sidewalk improvements and as-built survey have been completed and recommends that the security be released;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

1. That Subdivision Bond number IAC588316 in the amount of \$31,005.00 from Merchants Bonding Company, is hereby released as security for the satisfactory completion of the sidewalk improvements and as-built survey.
