ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 46-3 and 46-213(c)(2), relating to the fine for the use of Consumer Fireworks within the city limits.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending 46-3 and 46-213(c)(2), relating to the fine for the use of Consumer Fireworks within the city limits, as follows:

**Sec. 46-3. Violations.**

(d) A person who uses or explodes Consumer Fireworks in violation of this article commits a simple misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of \$~~625~~200.00.

**Sec. 46-213. Sale of Consumer Fireworks.**

(c) The following information must be stated in an easily readable type size and prominently posted at the place of payment at each location selling Consumer Fireworks:

(2) A violation of section 46-212(d) prohibiting the use or explosion of Consumer Fireworks within the city limits constitutes a simple misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of \$~~625~~200.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
