## APPROVING GUARANTEED MAXIMUM PRICE (GMP) AMENDMENT NO. 2 WITH MCGOUGH CONSTRUCTION CO., LLC FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK (CMR) SERVICES FOR THE CITY FACILITY EXPANSION PHASE 1 IMPROVEMENTS, NOT TO EXCEED \$17,889,445.75

**WHEREAS**, on June 14, 2022, the Governor of Iowa signed SF 183 which created Chapter 26A of the Iowa Code, Guaranteed Maximum Price Contracts, allowing for a governmental entity to follow the process set out in Chapter 26A to select a construction manager at risk for the construction of public improvements and providing for a guaranteed maximum price; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2023, the City Council authorized issuance of a Notice of Intent (NOI) to Enter into a Guaranteed Maximum Price Contract for the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements, including the City's selection criteria and further authorized staff to proceed in accordance with Chapter Iowa Code Chapter 26A, including issuing Request for Qualifications (RFQ), and Request for Proposals (RFP) to procure a Construction Manager at Risk (CMR), for the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements, including the process of securing a guaranteed maximum price contract in accordance with Chapter 26A of the Iowa Code for recommendation to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, following the requirements of Chapter 26A, staff prepared and issued a Notice of Intent (NOI), Request for Qualifications (RFQ), and Request for Proposals (RFP) to procure a Construction Manager at Risk (CMR) process for the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements and the selection committee evaluated responses to the RFQ and RFP in accordance with criteria set forth therein and interviewed three firms; and

**WHEREAS**, the selection committee selected and recommended the proposal submitted by McGough Construction Co., LLC for Construction Manager-At-Risk Services for the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 15, 2024, by Roll Call 24-0557, the City Council authorized and approved an agreement with McGough Construction Co., LLC for construction manager at risk services for the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements project, with preconstruction services, not to exceed \$71,120; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 16, 2024, by Roll Call No. 24-1219, the City Council approved a Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment No. 1 with McGough Construction Co., LLC to begin the interior demolition scope to expedite the construction schedule for the Project, not to exceed \$1,634,565; and

WHEREAS, McGough Construction Co., LLC is required to perform construction bid packaging and subcontractor procurement in compliance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 26A; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that if there is more than one Guaranteed Maximum Price Proposal submitted for the Project, then each subsequent proposal will incorporate the prior agreed upon Guaranteed Maximum Price to ensure there is one cumulative Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment No. 2 includes the \$1,634,565 for Amendment No. 1, \$75,595.75 for Change Order #2; and

WHEREAS, staff is recommending approval of the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment No. 2 with McGough Construction Co., LLC.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DES MOINES CITY COUNCIL:

1. That the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment No. 2 for the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements between the City of Des Moines and McGough Construction Co., LLC, Thomas McGough, Jr., President, 2737 Fairview Ave North, St. Paul, MN 55113, for an amount not to exceed \$17,889,445.75 for the construction of the City Facility Expansion Phase 1 Improvements project, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk, is hereby approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute, said amendment for and on behalf of the City of Des Moines, Iowa.
