HOLD HEARING FOR VACATION OF THE EAST/WEST ALLEY RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF 232 EAST 16TH COURT AND CONVEYANCE TO LINETTE QUINTANILLA FOR \$200.00

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2025, by Roll Call No. 25-1042, the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa voted to receive and file the recommendation from the City Plan and Zoning Commission that the east/west alley right-of-way in the vicinity of 232 East 16th Court, which is within the block bounded by East 16th Court and a north/south alleyway between Dean Avenue and East Court Avenue ("City Right-of-Way"), hereinafter more fully described, be vacated, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for all existing utilities in place until such time that they are abandoned or relocated at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, Linette Quintanilla, owner of 232 East 16th Court, has offered to the City of Des Moines ("City") the purchase price of \$200.00 for the vacation and purchase of the portion of alley right-of-way adjoining their property at 232 East 16th Court for assemblage with their adjoining property, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for all existing utilities in place until such time that they are abandoned or relocated, which price reflects the fair market value of the City Property as determined by the City's Real Estate Division; and

WHEREAS, there is no known current or future public need for the City Right-of-Way proposed to be vacated and sold, and the City will not be inconvenienced by the vacation and sale of said property; and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2025, by Roll Call No. <u>25-1399</u>, it was duly resolved by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the proposed vacation and conveyance of the alley right-of-way be set for hearing on November 3, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said proposal to vacate and convey the alley right-of-way was given as provided by law, setting forth the time and place for hearing on said proposal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Council direction, those interested in the proposed vacation and conveyance, both for and against, have been given an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. Upon due consideration of the facts and statements of interested persons, any and all objections to the proposed vacation and conveyance of the alley right-of-way, as described herein, are hereby overruled and the hearing is closed.
- 2. There is no public need or benefit for the alley right-of-way proposed to be vacated, and the public would not be inconvenienced by reason of the vacation of the north/south and east/west alley right-of-

- 7. Upon receipt of the recorded documents back from the Polk County Recorder, the Real Estate Division Manager shall mail the original of the Quit Claim Deeds and copies of the other documents to the grantees.



STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO THE P&Z COMMISSION

Staff recommends approval of the requested alley Right-of-Way vacation, subject to the reservation of easements for any existing utilities until such time that they are abandoned or relocated and subject to provision of any necessary no-build easements.

STAFF REPORT TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION

- 1. Purpose of Request: The proposed vacation would enable the Right-of-Way to be assembled with the adjoining property and maintained for private residential use.
- **2.** Size of Site: 16 feet by 172 feet (2,758 square feet).
- 3. Existing Zoning (site): "N3c" Neighborhood District.
- 4. Existing Land Use (site): The subject area is undeveloped alley Right-of-Way.
- 5. Adjacent Land Use and Zoning:
 - North "N3c"; Uses are one-household residential dwelling units.
 - South "N3c"; Use is a one-household residential dwelling.
- **6. General Neighborhood/Area Land Uses:** The applicant owns the parcel adjacent to the south of the alley Right-of-Way. The undeveloped alley Right-of-Way extends from East 16th Court to the east to a north/south alley between Dean Avenue and East Court Avenue. The surrounding area consists of predominantly low density residential with heavy industrial uses to the east.
- 7. Applicable Recognized Neighborhood(s): The subject property is within the Capitol East Neighborhood Association. All neighborhood associations were notified of the public hearing by emailing of the Preliminary Agenda on June 27, 2025, and of the Final Agenda on July 11, 2025. Additionally, separate notifications of the hearing for this specific item were mailed on June 27, 2025 (20 days prior to the public hearing) and July 7, 2025 (10 days prior to the public hearing) to the Neighborhood Association and to the primary titleholder on file with the Polk County Assessor for each property within 250 feet of the site.

All notices are mailed to the primary contact(s) designated by the recognized neighborhood association to the City of Des Moines Neighborhood Services Department on the date of the mailing.

- 8. Relevant Zoning History: None.
- 9. PlanDSM: Creating Our Tomorrow Land Use Plan Designation: Low Density Residential.
- **10.Applicable Regulations:** Taking into consideration the criteria set forth in Chapter 18B of the Iowa Code, the Commission reviews all proposals to vacate land dedicated for a

specific public purpose, such as for streets and parks, to determine whether the land is still needed for such purpose or may be released (vacated) for other use. The recommendation of the Commission is forwarded to the City Council.

II. ADDITIONAL APPLICABLE INFORMATION

- 1. **Utilities:** No existing utilities have been identified within the subject Right-of-Way. Easements must be reserved for any existing utilities until such time that they are abandoned or relocated.
- **2. Traffic/Access:** The requested vacation would not negatively impact access to private properties or impact traffic patterns.

III. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the requested alley Right-of-Way vacation, subject to the reservation of easements for any existing utilities until such time that they are abandoned or relocated and subject to provision of any necessary no-build easements.




