**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO PRAIRIE MEADOWS
COMMUNITY BETTERMENT PROGRAM FOR ENHANCED SPECIALIZED
COMMUNICATION FOR REGIONAL WATER, TECHNICAL RESCUE, AND
HAZMAT OPERATIONS**

WHEREAS, the ICON Water Trails project throughout the City of Des Moines and Central Iowa Region is being developed with several trailheads within the City opening or nearing completion; and

WHEREAS, completion of the ICON Water Trails is expected to bring thousands of residents and tourists into the water which is expected to increase the need for water-related service calls to the City’s Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, cities with comparable water parks have seen an increase of 1,000% for water-related service calls; and

WHEREAS, in anticipatory response to this increased need for water-related rescue services, the City’s Fire Department seeks to implement a “Rescue Swimmer” program; and

WHEREAS, due to unique circumstances faced by rescue swimmers, including boat engine noise, whitewater and river noise, and other “dead zones”, rescue swimmers are unable to communicate with ground or boat teams once they enter the water unless the City’s current communication infrastructure is upgraded; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has identified a communication system that would provide the functionality required to implement the rescue swimmer program; and

WHEREAS, City Staff have identified a source of potential funding for this communications system through the Prairie Meadows Community Betterment Program; and

WHEREAS, in order to be eligible for such grant funding, an application must be submitted not later than February 27, 2026; and

WHEREAS, City Staff have prepared an application for the Prairie Meadows Community Betterment Program grant in form attached hereto and on file in the office of the City Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:
