APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES APPLICABLE TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES UNDER CHAPTER 38 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND FIRE PREVENTION PERMITS FOR VARIOUS ACTIVITIES UNDER CHAPTER 46 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, Chapter 38 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines provides that fees for the use of emergency ambulance services provided by the City Fire Department specified in Section 38-26 shall be in the amounts set in a Schedule of Fees adopted by the City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 46 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines provides for fees for fire prevention permits for the installation, major repair, abandonment, or removal of for various activities listed in Section 46-1 to be in the amounts set in a Schedule of Fees adopted by the City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Schedule of Fees amending the fees relating to Chapter 38 and Chapter 46, respectively, have been prepared for Council consideration in form attached hereto and are recommended for adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the adopted Schedule of Fees for the City of Des Moines is hereby amended by amendment of the fees imposed pursuant to Chapter 38 and Chapter 46 of the City Code to be as set forth in the accompanying schedule, effective July 1, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to incorporate said amendment into the Schedule of Fees, and to maintain said amended Schedule of Fees on file in the offices of the City Clerk for public reference.

Foot notes:

1. Exemption: The license fee identified above shall apply only to the initial license for any flower pot or planter without signage. No license fee shall be charged for the renewal of a license for any flower pot or planter, if no signage is placed on the pot or planter.
2. Exemption: The license fee identified above shall apply only to the initial license for any awning, canopy or marquee. No license fee shall be charged for the renewal of a license for any awning, canopy or marquee.
3. Fee established by state law and can only be changed by state law
4. **NOTE REGARDING CALCULATION OF INSPECTION COST COMPONENT:** Pursuant to 23-56.01 (e) of the City Code, the base inspection cost component for excavation and obstruction permits is hereinabove expressed as a per square foot fee for the area to be excavated or obstructed, or impacted by excavation or obstruction. The fees for follow-up inspections, conducted after a permittee is informed of a violation of a specification or regulation in order to obtain compliance therewith, shall be at the hourly rate of \$50.00, which is based on the salary, benefit, and overhead costs to the city of the inspectors providing follow-up inspection services. Follow-up inspection services shall be charged to permittees on the basis of the number of hours of inspector time spent providing follow-up inspection services with respect to work performed in connection with each permit, multiplied by the applicable hourly rates on the schedule. The city engineer may waive the follow-up inspection fee on the initial follow-up inspection in the event a dispute over the occurrence of a violation is resolved in favor of the permittee, or for other good cause shown.
5. **NOTE REGARDING CALCULATION OF GIS COST COMPONENT:** The GIS cost component will only be applied to permits involving the placement of new equipment, the relocation of existing equipment, or a change of use or ownership of equipment requiring entry of data or notation into the GIS system. GIS mapping fee doesn't apply to service connections nor when user provides maps in acceptable GIS format.
6. **NOTE REGARDING PERMIT EXTENSIONS:** All excavation and / or obstruction work shall be completed within three (3) consecutive work days, or any other extension period granted in the permit, from the start of work. Permit extension is required if work is not completed within the permitted period. Permit extension fee to include the city cost component and the disruptive cost component for each additional three (3) workday extension and to be calculated as shown above. If the permit is issued with additional extension, the disruptive cost component will be charged for each five (5) day extension.
7. Foundation prices are total square inches multiplied by the square inch price equals the fee. Example: 28" x 18" foundation is 504 square inches multiplied by .63 cents per square inch, for a total of \$317.62
8. Exemption: The license fee identified above shall apply only to the initial license for any flower pot or planter without signage. No license fee shall be charged for the renewal of a license for any flower pot or planter, if no signage on the pot or planter.
9. Exemption: The license fee identified above shall apply only to the initial license for any awning, canopy or marquee. No license fee shall be charged for the renewal of a license for any awning, canopy or marquee.
10. Note: The sign area includes the area between letters and figures.
11. No fee shall be required for any sound equipment permit issued to the city, the state, or the federal government or a governmental subdivision or agency.
12. In addition to the fees, the owner shall pay the notification costs for property owners, publication costs and recording costs as established by the community development department.
13. In addition to such fee the applicant shall pay the estimated notification costs as determined by the Community Development Department
14. In addition to such fee the applicant shall pay the estimated notification to property owners as established by the community development department.
15. New Application – if the applicant **does not** currently hold a license or **has not** held a license within the previous 12 months
16. New Application – if the applicant **currently holds** a license or **has held** a license within the previous 12 months
17. Renewal – license that is currently in effect
18. Permanent or temporary transfer of license from one premise to another (not required if transfer is within 60 days prior to renewal date of an existing license)
19. If the term commences after July 1st of the first year, then the fee per square foot of licensed area for the remainder of the term of 3 calendar years shall be: \$3.75 (\$0.75 for the 1st year and \$1.50 per year for the 2nd and 3rd years) If the licensee is forced to vacate the adjoining business by no fault of its own prior to the expiration of the 2nd calendar year of the term, the City Manager or designee may, upon written request of such licensee, refund such portion of the fee for each unused full calendar year (\$1.50 sf) or unused full ½ calendar year (\$0.75 sf). 20. If the term commences after July 1st of the first year, then the rental per square foot of leased area for the remainder of the term of 3 calendar years shall be: \$3.75 (\$0.75 for the 1st year and \$1.50 per year for the 2nd and 3rd years). If the lessee is forced to vacate the adjoining business by no fault of its own prior to the expiration of the 2nd calendar year of the term, the City Manager or designee may, upon written request of such licensee, refund such portion of the rental for each unused full calendar year (\$1.50 sf) or unused full ½ calendar year (\$0.75 sf). Effective date: 06/13/2011.

21. Note: 20% of the gross price for the sale of internment spaces and ashes scattering are deposited in the respective cemetery perpetual care maintenance fund accounts. PCM amounts are calculated then rounded up to the nearest \$5.00 for each burial space, lot or plot, vault, crypt, columbarium, ashes scattering, and ashes placed in cement sold then indicated as such on our deposit. The examination fee required by Iowa Code Sec. 523I.80.8 to be submitted with the cemeteries' annual report shall not be included in the gross selling price.
22. *Late charge*: A late charge fee shall be levied against any funeral home or monument company this is delinquent in payment. Such fee shall be one percent after 30 days and 1.5 percent after 60 days.
23. The Glendale Lakeview Columbarium and Laurel Hill Block N packages include: the niche, the opening/closing fee, and the 1st and 2nd engravings. If a space was purchased prior to the package price effective date, opening/closing and engraving fees are separate.
24. Basic Life Support (BLS) Emergency is an immediate emergency response in which the Fire Department begins as quickly as possible to take the steps necessary to respond to the call. Basic Life Support (BLS) includes the provision of medically necessary supplies and services and BLS ambulance transportation as defined by the State of Iowa where the Fire Department provides the transport.
25. Advanced Life Support, Level 1 (ALS1) includes the provision of medically necessary supplies and services and the provision of an ALS assessment or at least one ALS intervention.
26. An Advanced Life Support, Level 2 (ALS2) includes the provision of medically necessary supplies and services, involving: at least three separate administrations of one or more medications by intravenous push/bolus or by continuous infusion (excluding crystalloid fluids), or at least one of these ALS2 procedures: manual defibrillation/cardioversion, endotracheal intubation, central venous line, cardiac pacing, chest decompression, surgical airway or intraosseous line.
