AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 114-3740 and repealing Section 114-2689, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Section 114-3740 and repealing Section 114-2689, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations, as follows:

Sec. 114-2689. ~~Ninth Street--Walnut Street to Locust Street~~ Repealed by Ord. No. --,---.

~~Ninth Street, on the west side, from Walnut Street to Locust Street, school passenger loading and unloading, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. school days.~~

Sec. 114-3740. Walnut Street--Ninth Street to Tenth Street.

Walnut Street, on the south side, from Ninth Street to Tenth Street, no parking any time.

~~Walnut Street, on the north side, from Ninth Street to Tenth Street, passenger loading and unloading, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, 20 minutes only.~~

Walnut Street, on the north side, from a point 90 feet east of Ninth Street to a point 35 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
