PROGRAM (TSIP) APPLICATION TO THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION (IOWA DOT) FOR THE 31ST STREET & WOODLAND AVENUE
MINI-ROUNDBOUT PROJECT.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

1. That the Fiscal Year 2028 Traffic Safety Improvement Program (TSIP) application for the 31st Street & Woodland Avenue mini-roundabout project is approved and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the application and the City Clerk to attest to the Mayor's signature.
2. The City Manager is authorized to submit applications to the Iowa DOT for TSIP Funds to cover a portion of the overall project cost for the 31st Street & Woodland Avenue mini-roundabout project.
3. The City understands if the application is approved it will be responsible for any additional funds, if required, to complete the project and the City of Des Moines will provide adequate resources to maintain the improvements for their useful life.
