SET HEARING FOR VACATION AND CONVEYANCE OF VARIOUS SEGMENTS OF RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE VICINITY OF 3001 LOGAN AVENUE TO THE STATE OF IOWA FOR \$13,280.00

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2008, by Roll Call No. 08-383, the City Council adopted a recommendation from the City Plan and Zoning Commission that portions of right-of-way adjoining the Iowa State Fairgrounds, hereinafter more fully described, be vacated and sold; and

WHEREAS, the grantee identified below is the owner of property abutting such rights-of-way and has offered to the City of Des Moines the purchase price identified below for the vacation and purchase of the portion of such rights-of-way described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

1. That the City Council of the City of Des Moines shall consider adoption of an ordinance permanently vacating portions of Logan Avenue, East 30th Court, and alleys adjoining the Iowa State Fairgrounds, more specifically described as follows:

Parcel A

All that part of East 30th Court (previously known as Elbert Street) right-of-way lying East of and adjoining the East/West alley right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 4 through 12, Block B, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat and lying East of and adjoining Lot 12 of said Block B, and lying East of and adjoining Logan Avenue lying South of and adjoining said Block B, and lying East of and adjoining Block C of said Cotton Mill Addition, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Parcel B

All that part of Logan Avenue right-of-way lying North of and adjoining Lots 1 through 12, Block C, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Parcel C

All that part of the East/West alley right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 4 through 12, Block B, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Parcel D

All of the East/West alley right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 1 through 12, Block C, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

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2. That if the City Council decides to vacate the above described rights-of-way, the City of Des Moines proposes to sell such rights-of-way, as described below to the grantees and for the consideration identified below:

To: State of Iowa for \$13,280.00

Parcel A

All that part of vacated East 30th Court (previously known as Elbert Street) right-of-way lying East of and adjoining the East/West alley right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 4 through 12, Block B, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat and lying East of and adjoining Lot 12 of said Block B, and lying East of and adjoining Logan Avenue lying South of and adjoining said Block B, and lying East of and adjoining Block C of said Cotton Mill Addition, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Parcel B

All that part of vacated Logan Avenue right-of-way lying North of and adjoining Lots 1 through 12, Block C, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Parcel C

All that part of the vacated East/West alley right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 4 through 12, Block B, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Parcel D

All of the vacated East/West alley right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 1 through 12, Block C, Cotton Mill Addition to Grand Park, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

- 3. That the meeting of the City Council at which the adoption of said ordinance and the sale and conveyance of such real estate is to be considered shall be on April 21, 2008, said meeting to be held at 5:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber.
- 4. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of said proposal in the form hereto attached all in accordance with §362.3 of the Iowa Code.
- 5. The proceeds from the sale of this property shall be deposited into the following account: 2007-08 Operating Budget, Page 259, Property Maintenance, SP767.
