

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department requested the Finance Department Procurement Division to order Trimble Global Positioning System (GPS) survey equipment for use by the Survey Section with existing Trimble GPS survey equipment and to allow the City to be compatible with the Iowa Department of Transportation's new system of GPS base stations; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator has determined that Trimble GPS survey equipment is available from Precision Midwest, 30W 196 Calumet Ave., Warrenville, IL 60555, the sole area wide distributor; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a)(7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing city need, materials or equipment to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from ENG041000/Construction & Support - Survey; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the Engineering Department recommend the sole source purchase from Precision Midwest;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City <u>Council</u> hereby accepts and approves the non-competitive purchase of Trimble GPS survey equipment from Precision Midwest at a total cost of \$30,218.50. (Council Communication No. 08-296)
