APPROVING AND ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY AMOUNTS FOR VIOLATION OF DEPOSIT OF YARD DEBRIS ONTO CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY AND PROPERTY IN VIOLATION OF CHAPTER 98 AS AUTHORIZED BY THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES

WHEREAS, section 98-79.02 of the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, as amended by Ordinance No. 14, 792, enacted on August 25, 2008, provides for the giving of an administrative notice of violation and assessment of an administrative penalty for violation of section 98-70 of the Municipal Code, the amounts of which administrative penalties are to be set in a Schedule of Administrative Penalties adopted by the City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, a Schedule of Administrative Penalties has been prepared for council consideration and is recommended for adoption, which Schedule of Administrative Penalties is appended hereto and is now on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA that the Schedule of Administrative Penalties appended hereto is hereby approved and adopted.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Schedule of Administrative Penalties shall be maintained on file in the Office of the City Clerk for public reference, and that the penalties therein established shall become effective upon and as of August 26, 2008.
