AMENDMENT ONE TO THE 2008 CDBG HANSEN HOUSE PROJECT

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2007, by Roll Call No. 07-2231, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan and authorized and directed the City Manager to submit the 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, included in the 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan was an allocation of \$40,000 of 2008 CDBG funding for the Hansen House Project as recommended by the City's Neighborhood Revitalization Board (NRB); and

WHEREAS, the Housing Services Department has prepared Amendment One to the 2008 Hansen House Project, which reduces "Salaries and Benefits" by \$7,945 and increases "Commodities" by \$4,500 and "Contractual Services" by \$3,445.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the 2008 Hansen House Project is amended as follows:

- 1. That "Salaries and Benefits" are reduced by \$7,945 and "Commodities" increased by \$4,500 and "Contractual Services" by \$3,445.
- 2. Notwithstanding this amendment, all other terms and conditions of the original contract remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attach a copy of this amendment to the 2008 Hansen House Project on file with the City.
