WHEREAS, funding is also requested in the grant application for mandatory attendance of two employees to two Department of Justice-sponsored grant meetings; and

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement; and,

WHEREAS, the grant application is requesting \$104,251.60, (\$100,407.60 for officer overtime and \$3,844 for travel); and,


WHEREAS, the grant is for a two-year period;




