WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 364.4 and 384.25 of the City Code of Iowa, notice of the hearing on the authorization of a Supplement No. D-1 to the Governmental Lease-Purchase Master Agreement between the City of Des Moines and DeLage Landen Public Finance LLC ("Master Lease"), in the principal amount of not to exceed \$800,000 (the "Supplement"), and the proposed action by the City Council to institute proceedings for the issuance of said Supplement has been given for the purpose of paying costs of acquiring certain equipment described as six heavy-duty trucks with plows and ice-control equipment;
