SELECTION AND APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT WITH DES MOINES UNIVERSITY FOR OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SERVICES

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2009, the City issued a Request for Proposal ("RFP") to select a qualified vendor to provide occupational health services; and

WHEREAS, two companies submitted proposals to provide occupational health services; and

WHEREAS, a committee representing the police, fire, public works, parks, aviation departments reviewed the proposals; and

WHEREAS, Des Moines University, the Honorable Terry Branstad, President, 3200 Grand Ave., Des Moines, Iowa 50312 submitted the lowest bid for occupational health services as outlined in the attached council communication; and

WHEREAS, the current occupational health services agreement (also with Des Moines University) expires on June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City select Des Moines University to provide occupational health services for the period July 1, 2009-June 30, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

1. That Des Moines University is selected as the provider for occupational health services and the legal department is directed and authorized to negotiate an agreement with Des Moines University for such services for a term of three years; and

2. The Mayor is authorized to execute such agreement as approved by the legal department for and on behalf of the City of Des Moines, Iowa and as attested to by the City Clerk.
