**AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF
STP AND STP-TE FUND FY2014 APPLICATIONS TO THE
DES MOINES METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION**

WHEREAS, The City of Des Moines is a full member of the Des Moines Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, the Federal Surface Transportation Program provides funding to local jurisdictions for the construction of eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, the program is administered by the Des Moines Area MPO that prioritizes and ranks all project applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit applications to the Metropolitan Planning Organization for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) and Transportation Enhancement (TE) funds for the following projects:

STP Project Applications

1. (STP) Major Construction Category: Southeast Connector Improvement – SE 14th Street to SE 18th Street
2. (STP) Major Construction Category: East Indianola Avenue Widening – McKinley Avenue to Army Post Road
3. (STP) Major Construction Category: Park Avenue Widening – Monarch Cement RR Tracks to SW 63rd Street
4. (STP) Major Construction Category: East Douglas Avenue Widening – E 42nd Street to E 56th Street
5. (STP) Minor Construction Category: Beaver Avenue and Urbandale Avenue Intersection Improvement
6. (STP) Preservation Category: Grand Avenue Bridge over the Des Moines River
7. (STP) Preservation Category: South Union Street Bridge over Yeader Creek.

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- 8. (STP-TE) Bicycle/Pedestrian Trails: Ewing Park – Easter Lake Park Trail Connection
- 9. (STP-TE) Bicycle/Pedestrian Trails: Superblock Trail Connections
- 10. (STP-TE) Scenic/Environmental: Drake Area Streetscape Project
- 11. (STP-TE) Scenic/Environmental: SE 14th Street Beautification at McKinley Avenue

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That if STP or TE funds are approved for one or more of these projects, the required local matching funds will be included in the future Capital Improvements Program, and the City will adequately maintain the project for its intended public use for a minimum of 20 years following the completion.
