RESOLUTION INITIATING THE NAMING OF THAT PORTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY 69 EXTENDING NORTH FROM EAST COUNTY LINE ROAD TO WHERE IT CONVERGES WITH SE 14TH STREET AS "SOUTHRIDGE BOULEVARD"

WHEREAS, that portion of U.S. Highway 69 in the area recently annexed into the City of Des Moines and located south of E County Line Road was named Southridge Boulevard by Ordinance No. 14,865 passed July 13, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, that portion of US Highway 69 extending north from E County Line Road to where it converges with SE 14th Street does not have an official City street name; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Development Director has proposed that the unnamed portion of U.S Highway 69 extending north from County Line Road to where it converges with SE 14th Street be named Southridge Boulevard to match the name given to US Highway 69 south of E County Line Road; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the proposal to name that portion of U.S. Highway 69 extending north from E County Line Road to where it converges with SE 14th Street as Southridge Boulevard is hereby referred to the City Manager and the City Plan and Zoning Commission for report and recommendation in conformance with the Policy for Naming of Streets, Facilities and Park Land in the City of Des Moines, adopted by Roll Call No. 09-801 on May 4, 2009.
