WHEREAS, the Police Department requested the Finance Department Procurement Division to purchase one bomb disposal robot for use by the Bomb Squad; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator has determined that such equipment is only available from ICOR Technology, 5459 Canotek Road, Ottawa, Canada K1J 9M3 (Hany Guirguis/President), the manufacturer and sole area wide distributor; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a)(7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing city need, materials or equipment to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from POL985322; HSGP Buffer Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the Police Department recommends the sole source purchase of the aforementioned equipment from ICOR Technology;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the non-competitive purchase of one bomb disposal robot from ICOR Technology, at a total cost of \$67,384.35.
