Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa, 50309 at which time any resident or taxpayer of the City may be heard for or against the proposed budget amendment and change

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of the hearing in the attached form in the Des Moines Register, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 362.3 not less than four (4) nor more than twenty (20) days prior to the date set for hearing.
