BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA: That Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the Professional Services Agreement between the City of Des Moines and Snyder & Associates, Inc., David Moeller, President, 2727 SW Snyder Blvd., Ankeny, IA 50023, to design the pedestrian underpass and trail connections in Ewing Park as part of Phase 2 of the East Indianola From SE 14th Street to Army Post Road, on the basis of hourly rates with total compensation for project services not to exceed \$33,500, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk, is hereby approved as to form and content.

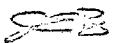
