WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (a)(7) provides for a non-competitive procurement of goods and/or services that are of such a nature that they are the only goods and/or services which will fit and comply with the required use, or are an integral part of a total system so as to be uniquely compatible with existing city need, materials or equipment to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, funding is available from ENG041000/Construction & Support – Survey; and

WHEREAS, the Procurement Administrator and the Engineering Department recommend the sole source purchase from Precision Midwest;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Des Moines City Council hereby accepts and approves the non-competitive purchase of Trimble S6 Robotic Total Station survey equipment from Precision Midwest at a total cost of \$37,330.50.
