WHEREAS, the City Plan and Zoning Commission has advised that at a public hearing held on June 17, 2010, its members voted 10-1 in support of a motion to recommend **DENIAL** of a request from Wade and Mary Krieg (owners), 691 Harwood Drive, finding that preservation of the requested portion of I-235, serving as a walkway connection, is an essential public purpose and therefore should not be removed by the IDOT from the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS the City Plan and Zoning Commission encouraged coordinated effort among the IDOT, City and Ingersoll Park Neighborhood Association to develop a plan to maintain and improve the connection so that it is an amenity to the neighborhood rather than a detriment to the immediately adjoining property owners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Traffic and Transportation Division is directed to coordinate communication between the IDOT, City and Ingersoll Park Neighborhood Association toward achieving this objective.
